



BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

In as much as the Green Schools Alliance and the National Conservation Training Center and the teaching staff, as well as the chaperones for this trip, will be assuming the supervisory responsibilities of your child at the conference away from home and school, we feel it is important that the student and the parents/guardians fully understand the rules which govern the conference. It is our feeling that this program is a continuation of the school day and as such, students participating as *Green Schools Fellows* are subject to the same rules and regulations that govern behavior at school while they are on our campus. Because the students will be representing their schools, we have established the following additional guidelines which must be adhered to while they are attending the conference:

1. I will conduct myself in a manner that will contribute to a sense of community among all participants and foster an atmosphere of mutual respect.
2. I will follow the rules set forth in the GSA – NCTC guidelines including the dress code.
3. There will be no use of alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco or any illegal substances.
4. All medications will be reviewed with the medical director during check-in and must be referenced in the Health Release form completed by the parent or guardian.
5. Rooms will be assigned by NCTC and may be changed only by the chaperones.
6. Under no conditions at any time will members of the opposite sex be in the same room without the presence of an authorized chaperone.
7. By curfew time or the time established for bed check, students are to be in their assigned rooms and are to remain there for the rest of the night.
8. No students will be allowed to leave the group on their own or with friends without the permission of their assigned chaperone. This includes leaving in cars, cabs, busses, etc., other than the transportations arranged by the chaperones.
9. Students will be held responsible for any loss or damage to their assigned rooms.
10. Students are to realize that there are other guests at the conference center and therefore, will be respectful of property and impact on others.
11. The luggage and personal effects of the students are subject to inspection prior to departing and at anytime during the conference.
12. Students will be expected to know and observe the time and locations of all departures.
13. The establishment and enforcement of any guidelines not covered here specifically, guidelines that are necessary to insure the success of the conference, will be left to the discretion of the chaperones.

I understand that any infraction of the above listed rules may result in my immediate dismissal from the conference, and that I may be sent home at my parents/guardians expense and that I may be subject to further disciplinary action consistent with local, state, and federal law.
